NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF NEW COUNTY ELECTION PRECINCTS**

The Commissioners Court of Kaufman County has entered an order, dated November 21, 2011, adopting new county election precincts. The county's election precincts must be redrawn in order to comply with Chapter 42 of the Texas Election Code and to insure that suitable polling places are located in each county election precinct. Some county election precincts and polling places must be changed to ensure that suitable accessible public accommodations are available within each election precinct.

A brief description of the changes to the election precincts is included with this notice.

The order of the Commissioners Court adopting new county election precincts and a map showing the new election precincts and the location of all polling places is available for public inspection during normal business hours at the County Clerk's Office in the Kaufman County Courthouse, 100 West Mulberry, Kaufman, Texas 75142 Monday through Friday from now until December 30, 2011. ## Kaufman County – Description of Changes to Election Precincts

1	Loses territory to Precinct 23 at County Road 143; Gains all of Precinct 2 and part of Precinct 36
2	Consolidated into Precinct 1; Renumbering of Precincts 13, 14 and part of 36
3	Loses territory to Precinct 4 along FM 741 – Commissioner Lines
4	Gains territory from Precinct 3 along FM 741 – Commissioner Lines
5	Loses territory outside the City of Terrell and gains territory inside the City of Terrell to conform to Single Member District 3
6	Loses territory inside the City of Terrell to Precinct 5; Gains territory from Precinct 8 and territory from Precinct 9 to County Road 349
7	Renumbered to Precinct 8; Renumbering of Precinct 40
8	Consolidated into Precinct 6 except for area within the City of Terrell where it conforms to Single Member District 4
9	Loses territory northeast of County Road 349 to Precinct 6; Loses territory inside the City of Terrell to Precinct 5
10	Gains all of Precinct 11
11	Consolidated with Precinct 10; Renumbering in City of Forney Precinct 32
12	Gains territory from the western side of Precinct 33 – new boundary at CR 4055 then south to CR 4056, then south to CR 4051, then south to CR 4048
13	Existing Precinct 13 consolidated into Precinct 2
14	Loses territory to Precinct 21 at FM 429 and County Road 104; Loses another small portion to Precinct 21 along Rocky Cedar Creek; Renumbering of Precinct 32
15	Gains Precinct 31 (all) and portions of Precincts 33 and 41 to follow the Mabank/Kemp ISD boundary
16	Loses small area along the Mabank/Kemp ISD boundary; Gains territory from Precinct 41; Gains all of Precinct 39 – all to conform to Mabank/Kemp ISD boundary
17	No change
18	Gains territory to include the entire City of Crandall; Gains territory from Precinct 29 to the Crandall ISD boundary line
19	Gains territory in the City of Terrell and conforms to Single Member District 5
20	Gains territory from Precinct 38 outside the city limits of Terrell; Gains territory from Precinct 27 (all); Gains small area of Precinct 26 just outside the city limits of Terrell
21	Gains territory from Precinct 14; Gains all but a small portion of Precinct 35
22	Gains Precinct 42 (all)
23	Gains territory in Precinct 1 at County Road 143; Gains small portion of Precinct 35
24	Gains territory from Precincts 5 and 34 up to the Terrell city limit line
25	Loses territory to Precinct 7; Gains territory from Precinct 37; Loses territory to Precinct 13 to conform to the City of Forney city limits
26	Loses territory to Precinct 20 outside the city limits of Terrell; Loses territory from Precinct 5 to conform with Terrell Single Member District 2
27	Consolidated with Precinct 20 outside the City of Terrell and consolidated with Precinct 19 inside the City of Terrell; 27 is now a renumbering of 37
28	No change

35	Eliminated by consolidation with Precincts 21 and 23
36	Eliminated by consolidation with Precinct 2
37	Eliminated by consolidation with Precincts 25, and a small portion of 29 to conform with Commissioner Lines; <b>Renumbered to Precinct 27</b>
